HANDICAPPING INFO

To enable automatic handicapping in League Play, select the Parity/Handicap Option in the League Matches Menu (only in Elite Software) and follow the on-screen instructions. Games are handicapped based on the rating points differential of the players involved in the immediate game (Singles, Doubles or Trios). If a team is under the published lower limit for the flight, it will be the responsibility of said team's Captain to add a point(s) to ANY player(s) on the team to bring the team up to the published lower limit for the flight. The additional rating point(s) applies to all games in all matches.

The net downward or upward rating movement of players and teams will establish the handicaps for the Playoffs and Finals.

ROUND LIMITS

During League Play and at Major Medalist Tournaments, Round Limits will be 25 Rounds:

In Cricket, if the round limit is reached, the game will be decided by marks recorded (not points). In the event of a tie, points scored will be the tie breaker. If a tie then exists, the player(s) involved in the game will shoot one round of Count-Up (per involved player) with the total score determining the winner.

In '01, if the round limit is reached, the team (player) with the fewest remaining points wins the game. If a tie exists, the player(s) involved in the game will shoot a round of Count-Up (per involved player) with the total score determining the winner.

GENERAL INFO

If a tie exists upon the completion of Match Play, the games won in the head to head matches will be utilized as a tie breaker, including 1st place ties. If, after the tie breaker, the teams are still tied playoff positioning will be picked by the computer and the involved teams will be acknowledged as finishing in the highest of the positions in contention and receive and/or share all of the awards associated with said position.

Exception: If, after the tie breaker, there is still a 1st place tie the tied teams will play a playoff match to determine 1st place. The team that loses said match will then be recognized as 2nd place for playoff positioning.
